APPALACHIA MISSION TRIP



The region known as **Appalachia** is a 205,000 square mile territory that follows the spine of the Appalachian Mountains from southern New York to northern Mississippi. Historically, the Appalachian economy has been dependent upon coal mining, agriculture, and heavy industry, which led to widespread economic depression as industries changed or left. Combined with a lack of infrastructure and healthcare scarcity, the last 40 years saw very hard times for the people of Appalachia.

Our **Appalachia mission teams** are currently serving in Southeastern Kentucky. Much of this region was ravaged by recent floods and tornadoes, and encompasses eight of the fifty most impoverished counties in the USA.

Come and serve communities steeped in history in a **quintessentially American region** among the beauty of the Appalachian Mountains.
